Farma, CFP® Scholarship to honor the memory of Anthony (Tony) Farma, who died over the weekend. Tony, an active FPA member, teacher, mentor and friend was just elected to the 2005 Board of Directors. "Tony embodied the spirit of adult education and was a wonderful educator and mentor. He has touched many lives and will be missed by many people", said Debra Neiman, CFP®, President.

The FPA of MA gives out two \$500 scholarships twice each year – in the winter and fall semesters – to student members who are pursuing the CERTIFIED FINANCIAL PLANNER designation and taking the curriculum at accredited local institutions, such as: Boston University, Bentley College, Merrimack College, Northeastern University, and Suffolk University. The FPA of MA has awarded four scholarships since the scholarship program inception in 2004.

Neiman added "by naming the scholarship after Tony, we hope that his passion for learning and his commitment to the financial planning profession will be passed on to the scholarship recipients and the membership at large. "
